SB793 SENATE BILL







WHAT IS SB 793?



- The bill bans the sale of <u>flavored tobacco</u> <u>products</u> and <u>tobacco flavor enhancers</u>.
- The bill **includes**:
 - Flavored cigarettes, e-cigarettes, e-hookah, e-juice, chewing tobacco, RYO cigarette tobacco, snuff, little cigars, cigarillos, and snus.
- The bill doesn't include:
 - Premium cigars with a wholesale price of at least \$12, loose-leaf tobacco (cut or shredded pipe tobacco) which can't be used for making cigarettes such as RYO, and shisha tobacco products used for hookah.

WHERE IT STANDS NOW



- A referendum was submitted that has delayed implementation of the bill until 2022.
- The bill will now be on the California ballot in November 2022.



- If it passes, the bill will go into effect in December 2022.
 - Penalties would include a \$250 fine,
 for each violation, to the retailer.
- If it doesn't pass, SB 793 will not become a law.
